In our cooperative Religious Education Program each family is required to participate in support of the program. Below is a description of each volunteer opportunity to help decide where you would like to be involved.

**RE Teacher or Assistant** – Be part of a teaching team approximately 8 times during the year. Use UU curricula to plan lessons and activities for various age groups. **These positions have been filled – if you are not an assigned RE teacher or assistant but are interested, please sign up for the Children’s Worship Team or Substitute.**

**Substitute Teacher** – Be available on long or short notice to fill in for a teaching team.

**Halloween Party** – Help plan and be part of a Halloween event for the children on Sunday November 1, 2009. (This will take place during service in the classrooms.)

**Intergenerational Day** – Help plan and/or lead a craft at our annual Intergenerational Day Event, to be held on December 6, 2009 from 11:30-2:00.

**Classroom Cleaning** – Quarterly “deep cleaning” of the Nursery, preschool room and RE kitchen.

**RE Committee** – The RE Committee meets the first Sunday of each month at 11:30 to steer the Religious Education Program for children and youth. **New members are always welcome.**

**Bake/Make Food for Events** – Like to cook? On occasion, prepare food for special events, usually desserts or appetizer type items.

**Easter Activities** – Help plan and be part of our Easter activities on Easter Sunday, April 4, 2010.

**Supply Snack After Service** – Bring in a child friendly snack for fellowship hour in the coffee room.

**Children’s Worship** – Be part of the team that plans the full-length monthly Children’s Worship service on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of each month. Or make a guest appearance with a story or song.

**Call me once for anything** – Be available to help with a one-time RE need this year.

**Other** – We are open to a special talent or new idea. Please specify.
